### STANDEN

**STANDEN** - Henrietta Sophia FRASER, a daughter of Sir William Fraser, Bart, married James Montresor Standen on 31<sup>st</sup> August 1819, at Windlesham in Surrey. Henrietta was born on 29<sup>th</sup> January 1796 and baptised at St George the Martyr, Queen's Square, London on 5<sup>th</sup> March of that year. She was about two years younger than her sister, Jean Helen Fraser, who married Dr John GROVE.

James Montresor Standen (born 1795) was the son of Revd. John Hargrave Standen and Elizabeth PINNOCK. He died in 1834, aged only 39, leaving his widow, Henrietta and their five known children:

1. James Henry Standen, the eldest son. He became a barrister, Administrator General and Registrar of the 'Diocese of Bombay'. He died in Penang in 1858.
2. Henrietta Jean Standen, born 1827, Middlesex.
3. Revd. William Standen, born 1828, Clapham, Surrey. He became vicar of Long Sutton, Hampshire.
4. Major General Douglas Standen, born 1830, Clapham, Surrey. He married Annie Ashton LIDDELL. The couple has fourteen children. Douglas died in 1903, on the Island of Guernsey, Channel Islands.
5. Julia Charlotte Standen, born 1832. In 1834, Charlotte Downes comments that Julia is "*very lively*" and in 1837 writes: "*.....Julia Standen a beautiful child*". Julia married in 1859, William Hector LYON, of Sherborne. The couple had seven known children. Julia died at Sherborne in 1898.

In 1837, the widow Henrietta Standen is found in several diary entries at the Close, Salisbury, with her sister Jean Grove and others within the Grove and Fraser families.

Note:

The 1841 census suggests there may have been another daughter, although possibly a cousin, a Mary Standen (b. ca 1826), who is at school with Henrietta (b. ca 1827) in Barnard Street, Salisbury.
