ST LO - Lewis George St Lo married Mary Anne Grove (daughter of William Frederick Grove, rector of Melbury Abbas) at Melbury Abbas in 1828. The couple lived at “Marsh Court”, Caundle Marsh, the wider St Lo family having earlier inhabited that area of Dorset, particularly Child Okeford and Sturminster Newton. Lewis’ forbear, The Revd. Henry St Lo (d. ca 1772) was a clerk of Sturminster Newton and was an executor of the will of Stafford MOORE (1712-1765) of “Freemans”, Puxey, near Sturminster.

Lewis and Mary Anne had three daughters – Mary Jane, Selina Isabel and Harriet Emma. The latter two girls both died unmarried, in their mid-late twenties. The eldest daughter, Mary Jane, married her second cousin, Henry Peter Auber, a solicitor, at Caundle Marsh, in 1853. They had six known children, including Isabel Johnanna (the name Johnanna recurs through successive generations of the Auber family) and Lewis Edmund St Lo Auber, whose second son, 2nd Lieut. Charles St Lo Auber died in 1916, during the Great War.
